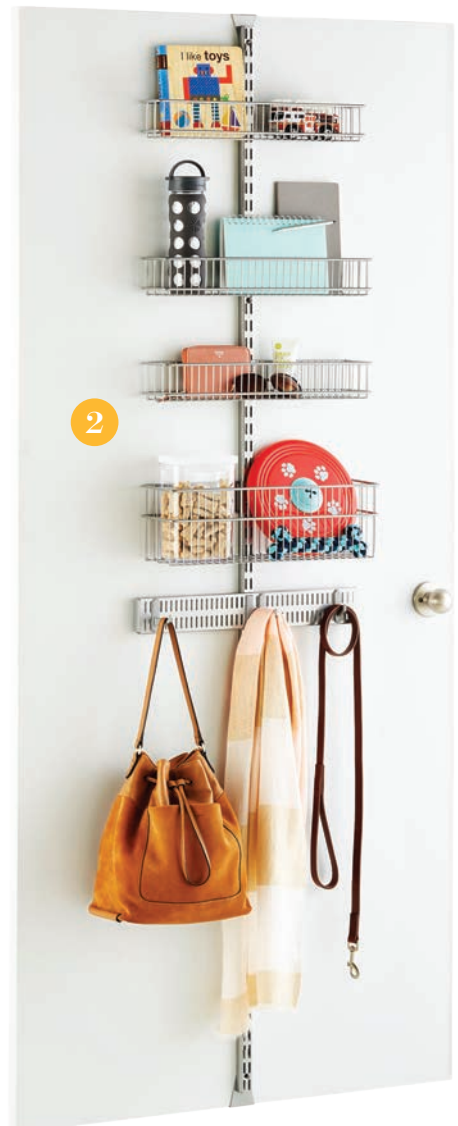


1 ALL IN ONE
