GIFTS Elevenzees (1901 W. Division St.; 773-772-1150) is great for housewarming gifts, baby gifts, candles. **Renegade Handmade** (1924 W. Division St.; 773-227-2707): It's fun to uncover new stuff there. Last year I gave Barack Obama and Bob Ross (remember him from the *Joy of Painting*) finger puppets by Abbychristine. **TATTOOS** Mat Moreno is my guy at **Insight Studios** (1062 N. Milwaukee Ave.; 773-342-4444). He's a genius.

WOMEN'S CLOTHING In Highland Park, where I live, I shop at **SHE Boutique** (483 Central St., Highland Park; 847-926-0150). Their stuff is young and kind of edgy. My secret shopping source is **theoutnet.com**: It sells after-season designer clothes from its sister site, **netaporter.com**. A beautiful Calvin Klein black jersey dress, originally \$3,000, was on sale for \$300. **VINTAGE FURNISHINGS** I go to **Anna's Mostly Mahogany** (531 Bank Ln., Highwood; 847-432-9151), which is a huge antique consignment store. It's so reasonably priced, it's crazy. **The Find** (9 Highwood Ave., Highwood; 847-266-1700) is a little higher end.

SHEET MUSIC Coulsons Music Matters (75-77 E. Van Buren St.; 312-461-1989) for jazz and classical. **Performers Music** (410 S. Michigan Ave., Ste. 904; 312-987-1196) for classical sheet music and books. **PIANOS** The sellers that I know personally are very fair: **Family Piano Co.** (114 S. Genesee St., Waukegan; 847-775-1988) and **Kurt Saphir Pianos** (123 Green Bay Rd., Wilmette; 847-256-5225). Kurt Saphir is terrific; I've known him for ages. **BIKE MAINTENANCE** I still have a license but no car. And I am not a good driver, so I stick to the bike—currently a vintage Schwinn. At **Quick Release Bike Shop** (1527 N. Ashland Ave.; 773-871-3110), Joe is my guy—for bikes and bike repair, this guy couldn't be greater.

ORGANIZING AND STORAGE SUPPLIES U-HAUL (**uhaul.com**) has the best deals for boxes and packing material. **CLOSET ORGANIZER** For a built-in unit, I recommend **CLOSET WORKS** (2000 N. Clybourn Ave.; 773-244-9700). **HOSTESS GIFTS** 1730 OUTLET COMPANY (1730 W. Wrightwood Ave.; 773-871-4331) is a great little outlet store that sells designer home décor and furniture.

VINTAGE I love **Designer Resale** (658 N. Dearborn St.; 312-587-3312) for vintage Hermès and Chanel. I also love the **Broadway Antique Market** (6130 N. Broadway; 773-743-5444) and **Edgewater Antique Mall** (6314 N. Broadway; 773-262-2525) and usually make an afternoon out of scouting around there. The highlights are amazing one-of-a-kind gifts. I like finding vintage coffee-table books there, too. Other recent finds include a vintage Gucci dice cup that I use for pens, '30s brass photo frames, and beautiful pottery. **STATIONERY** I just ordered custom stationery from **Kneen & Co.** (400 W. Erie St., Ste. 503; 312-787-7003). **MEN'S ACCESSORIES** Charvet knit silk ties—the skinny, preppy ones—from **Neiman Marcus** (737 N. Michigan Ave.; 312-642-5900) are a recent obsession.
